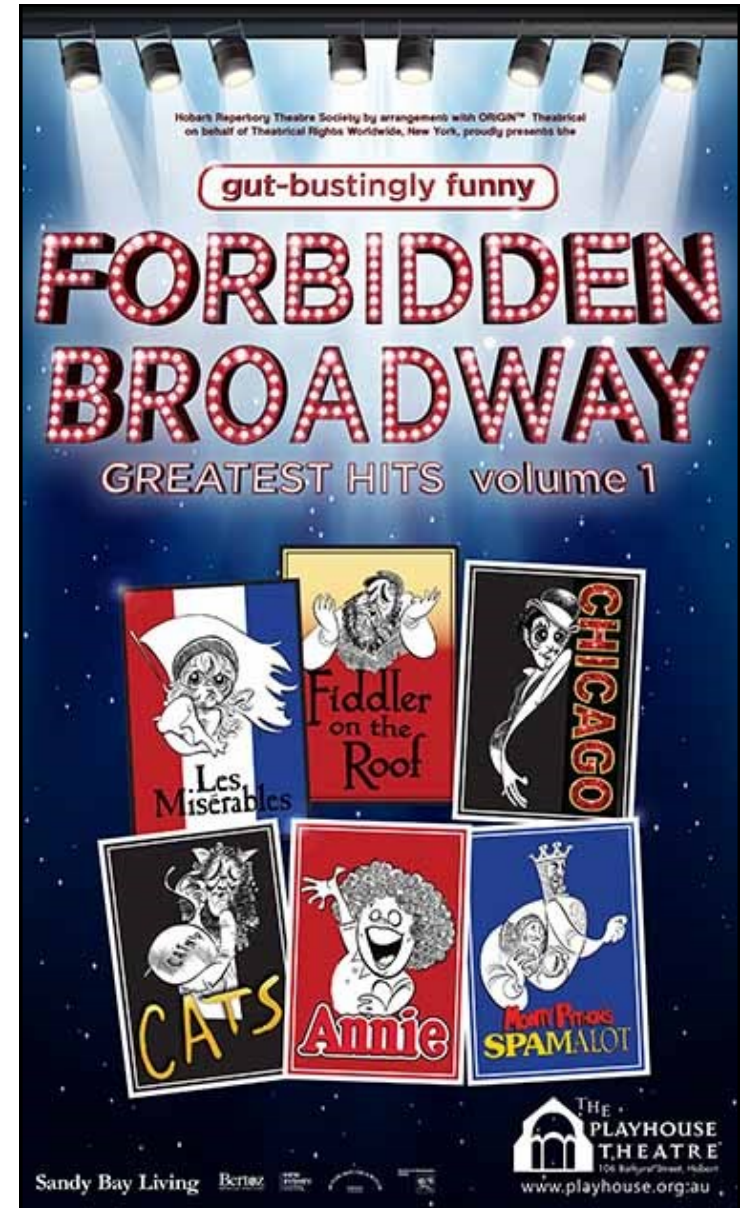

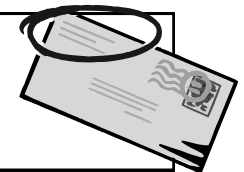

PARKING FOR SUNDAY MATINEES – HOBART REP SHOWS ONLY

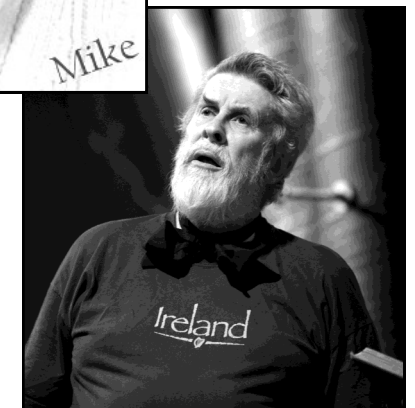
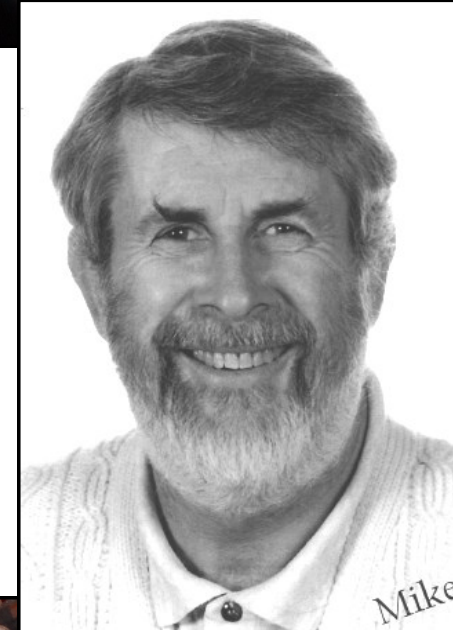
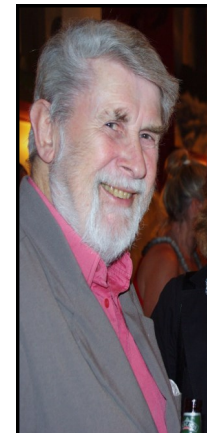

It is important to note that this arrangement does **NOT** extend to Sunday matinees presented by hirers of the theatre unless they themselves advise so.

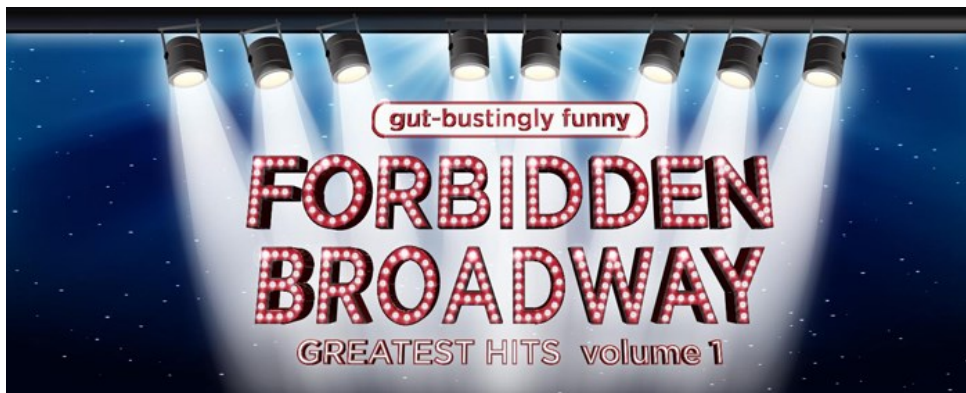
